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Note to teachers:

This table is intended to be adaptable, depending on the availability of weather-measuring tools. If you, for instance, do not have access to the equipment needed to measure wind speed, consider instead using graphics to communicate similar messages about weather conditions. A flag pole is a great graphic to use when speaking about wind speed because there is often access to one, nearby, to provide a clear indication of the wind's speed (direction, too!). Similarly, a drop of water can be adapted to speak about humidity (multiple droplets indicating greater humidity).
