Virtual Food Summit 2022 is this Wednesday

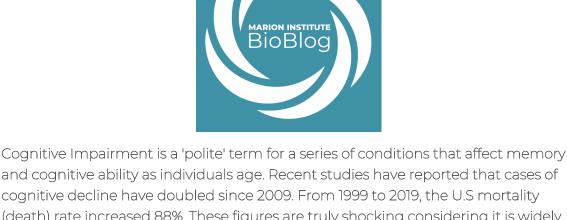

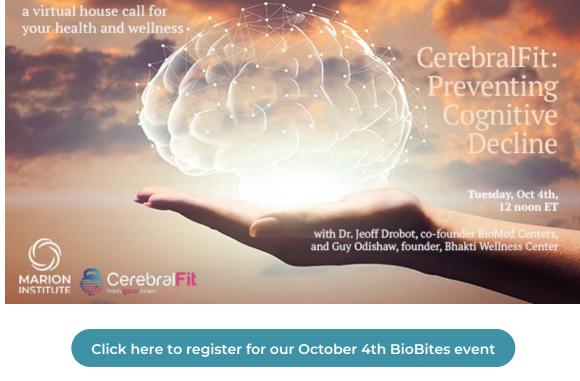
